ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

SUNDAY 21 SEPTEMBER 2025

CLOSURE AND REOPENING OF ROADS

- All roads around the route will close at 06:30, ready for the Run Shoreditch 10k to begin at 09:00, with the exception of Balls Pond Road which will close at 08:00 and our start/finish areas noted below.
- The Start area on Bridport Place & Grange Street (between Shoreditch Park and Penn Street) will be closed from 12:00 on Saturday 20 September to enable the start infrastructure to be set up. This area will re-open by 15:00 on Sunday 21 September.
- The Finish area on Mintern Street as well as Rushton Street & Bridport Place (between Rushton Street & Mintern St) will close at 05:00 on Sunday 21 September to enable the finish infrastructure to be set up. This area will re-open by 15:00 on Sunday 21 September.
- Roads will begin to re-open from 11:15,

- once runners have passed by, infrastructure has been removed and it is safe and feasible to do so. All race route roads will have reopened by 13:15.
- Advanced warning signs will be installed around the route two weeks prior to the event, indicating road closures.
- To help minimise the impact, Hackney & Islington Councils have suspended the enforcement of Low Traffic Neighbourhoods (LTN's) in the shaded area shown on the map overleaf, for the 24hr period on Sunday 21 September.
- If you usually receive mobile support in your home (such as a carer or meal deliveries) please ensure your service provider is aware of the closures.
- Emergency service and pedestrian access will be facilitated throughout.

PARKING SUSPENSIONS

- Parking suspensions will be in place on roads marked with a ® on the road list.
- Advanced notices of the parking restrictions will be installed in the week prior to the event, indicating where parking suspensions will be in place.
- Please note any vehicles parked in contravention of any parking restrictions will be removed by tow-truck.
- If you require your vehicle during the road closure times, we recommend you park outside of the road closure area.
